ESI personnel tapped the saddle tanks and refer tank then utilized a vacuum truck to collect the diesel fuel. ESI vacuum truck would later be disposed of with similar waste as bulk waste. ESI personnel secured the site and demobilized. collected in one (1) vacuum truck (175 gallons) and one (1) 55-gallon drum (350 pounds) for transport and disposal.
